Even though our rodeo is over for the year, our Evergreen Royalty is out there representing us and promoting our rodeo. Here's where they'll be over the next few months...

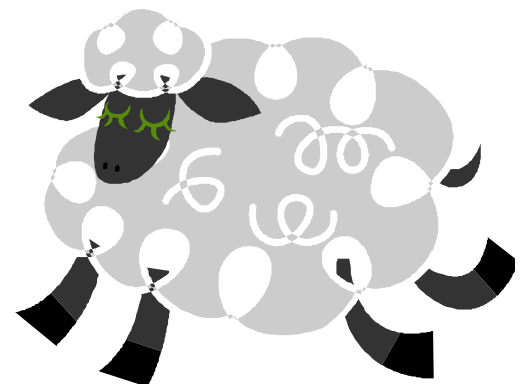
