## GENERAL INFORMATION

**Entry deadline:** June 6, 2011. A late fee of \$10 will be applied. Space is limited, so sign up early.

**Cancellations:** Must be made in writing or email by June 6, 2011, or your entry fee will be considered a donation to our non-profit, Evergreen Rodeo Association. Ditto, "no shows".

**Final information and line-up order:** Will be available on our website [www.evergreenrodeo.com](http://www.evergreenrodeo.com), parade menu, 5 days before the parade date.

**Entries must be decorated to promote our parade theme:** Exceptions are antique or custom autos, band and specialty entries. The parade committee reserves the right to make a final judgment on conformance. We look forward to having your entry in our Evergreen Rodeo Parade!

**Parade Route:** The parade begins at the junction of Hwy. 74 / Evergreen Parkway and the frontage road at Christ the King Catholic Church, just south of Safeway and north of the Upper Bear Creek intersection with Hwy. 74. The route will run past Evergreen Lake through downtown and end at Meadow Drive (Bradley's Gas Station). This is approximately one mile.

**Check-in and Position Numbers:** This will be coordinated along Hwy. 74, south of Safeway, from Troutdale Scenic Dr. to Christ the King Catholic Church on the frontage road. Please have your entry number available and designate one person from your group to check in. Drop-offs not permitted after 8:45 am and you must be in line and ready to go by 9:15 am, the parade kicks off promptly at 10 am. We encourage you to be early and parking or drop-offs are not allowed along Hwy. 74.

**Freebies, handouts:** To keep smaller children from running into the parade travel area, nothing can be thrown or tossed from your entry along the parade route. Candy and other items may be passed out to the crowd by walking pedestrians only. Violators may be pulled from the parade or not allowed future participation. This is non-negotiable due to safety and insurance reasons.

**Noise:** No firecrackers, poppers or similar items, air horns, loud amplifying system or the discharge of any firearm will be allowed. Any firearm carried shall be for display only.

**Trailer/horse parking:** You are responsible for cleaning up around your rig so please don't leave a hay/straw/manure mess in your area. Unfortunately, we do not have enough volunteers to take care of this - it is the thing to do, so thanks for helping us out!

**Parade Movement:** Please keep the spacing and pace to help keep the parade moving forward. There will be some expected and brief stoppage for specific approved maneuvers, bands and presentations. Please follow direction from the CO Rangers and our parade volunteers along the parade route if they request that you speed up or slow down.

**Be alert to other entries:** There are lots of horses, large floats and heavy machinery in the parade. They might not be able to see you when moving.

**Dismantling, end of the parade:** To avoid congestion and holding up the rest of the parade units, **please proceed around the corner by the gas station and up the hill on Meadow Drive before you unload participants or otherwise dismantle your entry.**

**Be prepared, be safe, and plan ahead:**

- It could be a warm and sunny day, so bring water and other fluids, sunscreen. Small animals and children walking in the parade need water, and small children might need to be carried or provided transportation if tired.
- Participants on bicycles, scooters, skates, skateboards, etc. must wear a helmet and proper safety equipment.
- An adult on foot must accompany riders on horseback under age 10.
- Parking is limited, please plan to carpool and remember that parking along Hwy. 74 (Evergreen Parkway) is prohibited.
- The CO Rangers and parade volunteers will assist with directions to parking areas.
- Arrange for needed pickup of participants at the end of the parade route along Meadow Drive.
