We are not owned, or operate, under the umbrella of a community, city, county, or any government organization. We, the association members, not only own the rodeo grounds property, we handle everything from top to bottom as volunteers!

Although the roots of the Evergreen Rodeo go back to the 1920's,

52 Years Ago - The community came together to build the arena at El Pinal. On June 10th, they broke ground. The ground was leveled, posts were set and the arena was built. Volunteers and the community shared their time, muscles, machinery, and donated much of the materials to make this happen for the Love of Rodeo.

52 Years Ago - Just seven weeks after ground was broken, the first rodeo was held in the El Pinal Arena on August 5th, 1967.

Fun fact: Esco Construction, Pete Honnen Implement Company (now known as Honnen Equipment Co.), and Public Service of Colorado (Now known as Xcel) were there to help build our arena so many years ago. They continue to support the Evergreen Rodeo to this day.
